John Thomas Holt was Born in London. He married Elsie Maud Grant of Bugbrooke in the second quarter of 1910 in Edmonton area of London and in 1911 was working as carpenter/joiner in Walthamstow .

He joined the Duke of Cambridge's Own (Middlesex Regiment) as private 5637, and died in action on the 27<sup>th</sup> of June 1916. He is commemorated on the Thiepval Memorial, Somme.

A Headstone and kerb in Bugbrooke Churchyard is inscribed 'In loving memory of Elsie Maud Holt, died 8<sup>th</sup> December 1968 aged 77 years, also John Thomas Holt husband of the above killed in action on the Somme 27<sup>th</sup> June 1916 aged 28 years "Reunited"'
