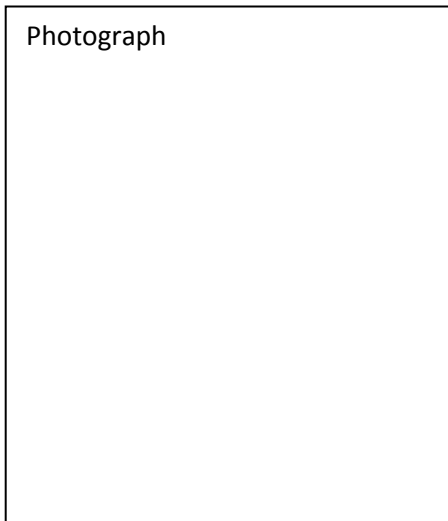

Joseph HOWARD was one of ten surviving children (of 11) of Thomas and Mary HOWARD.

Joseph's wartime service has not been traced and there are over 440 Medal Index Cards at The National Archives for soldiers in the same name alone.
