BUBB, H., Pte. 10th (Prince of Wales' Own) Hussars.

He volunteered in August 1914, and 11 months later was sent to France, where he fought in engagements at Ypres. On being transferred to the 2nd Gloucestershire Regiment he was drafted to Salonika, where he took part in fierce fighting on the Struma, the Doiran and the Vardar fronts. He was demobilised on his return to England in July 1919, and holds the 1914-15 Star, and the General Service and Victory Medals.
