Additional Information

Henry was born around 1897 in Marylebone, London. His father, Thomas Westle was a journeyman baker but by 1901 was already a widow. Thomas with his two sons, William and Henry was living at Buckingham House in Woking, Surrey in 1901 but by 1911 Henry was at a Dr Barnados home – The Watts Naval Training School at Elmham in Norfolk

In between 1901 and 1911, Henry had spent time in Bugbrooke and had attended school there.

Henry joined the Northamptonshire Regiment with service number 12694. On the 14th April 1916 he was killed and is commemorated with a headstone in the Vermelles British Cemetary near Lens in the Pas de Calais. He died just 7 months before his brother William.
