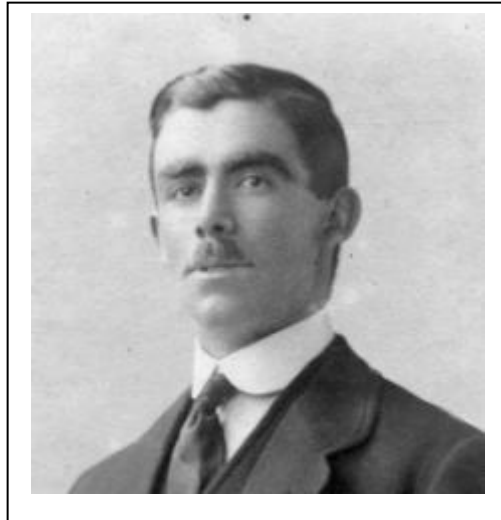

Volunteered in September 1914, as a Trooper in the Warwickshire Yeomanry. Trained with them in East Anglia until April 1915, when the regiment sailed from Avonmouth on the 'Wayfarer'. Torpedoed off the Scilly Isles, he eventually sailed again on the 'Lake Manitoba' for Alexandria. After 3 weeks, they went to fight in August 1915 in Gallipoli.
