Volunteering in November 1914, he was retained on important work at Norwich until 1916, when he was drafted to Salonika. On that front he saw much service in operations on the Vardar and the Doiran, but contracted malaria and was invalided to England in 1918. On his discharge from hospital he was stationed at Park Royal until demobilised in February 1919, holding the General Service and Victory Medals.
